Reporting to the Manager of Specialized Services, the incumbent will be responsible for the following functions:

- Knowledge and understanding of client centred mental health and addictions interventions and practice methods
- Conducting and completing detailed interRAI Assessment and synoptic report for individuals referred;
- Will coordinate with the MHEART RN needed education regarding medication and potential side effects as well as the dispensing of medication where required
- Providing crisis prevention and intervention planning with the intention of preventing a relapse and/or hospitalization: including single sessions where needed using modalities such as CBT/DBT, Solution Focused and/or Single Session Therapies
- Compiling relevant case histories and gathering collateral information;
- Participating in Case Disposition meetings as needed to determine outcomes for individuals referred to the Agency;
- Exploring and linking individuals to external community resources to meet mental or physical health needs;
- Communicating and coordinating relevant information with agency staff and police;
- Responding and coordinating care with Bluewater Health Psychiatry, Emergency Department Physicians and Psychiatric Assessment Nurses.
- Provide community presentations as needed

Qualifications:

Education required:

- Registered Nurse current registration with the College of Nurses of Ontario (preferably with Canadian Certification in Psychiatric/Mental Health Nursing), and/or
- Masters of Social Work Degree from an accredited university with current registration with the Ontario College of Social Workers and Social Service Workers or Masters of Counselling Degree currently registered with College of Psychotherapy
- experience and a detailed knowledge of serious mental illness, usually gained by 5-7 years of working with this population; and
- a valid Ontario Driver's Licence and access to a vehicle are required
