About Us

CMHA Lambton Kent serves Chatham-Kent and Sarnia Lambton with programs, services and partnerships that help people maintain and improve their mental health. We offer similar services in each community with some differences. We work with our partners to make sure we are not all offering the same care and that we are working together for healthier communities.

The purpose of this information sheet is to help you understand where to start if you believe that you or someone close to you may need help with their mental health or substance use concerns. This is not a fulsome overview of all of our programs and services but it will be enough to get you started.
